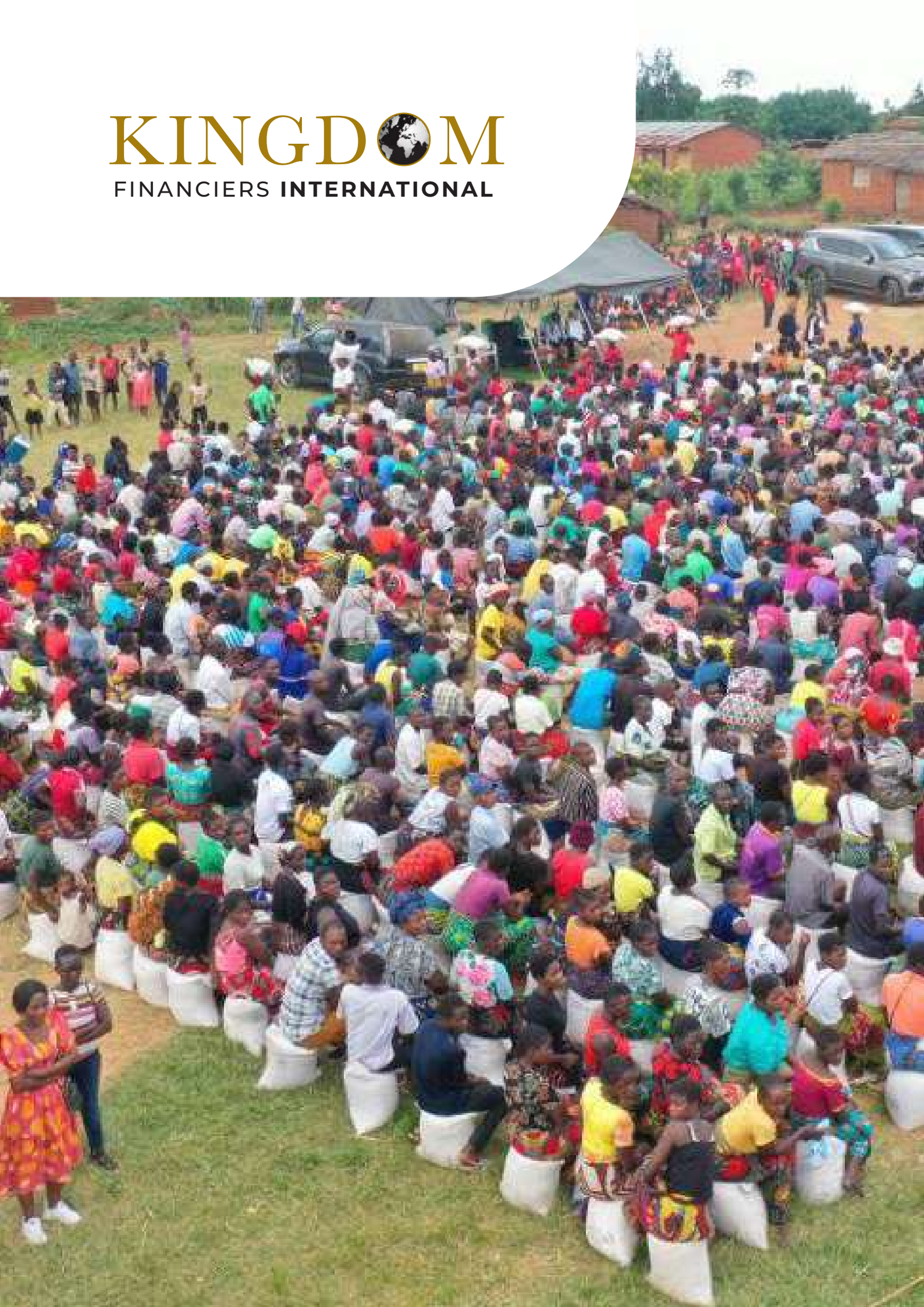

# KFMI DONATES TO PRISONERS AND THE NEEDY IN MULANJE, MALAWI

On Thursday 27th July 2023, partners of the Major Prophet Dr. Shepherd Bushiri operating under the Kingdom Financing Millionaires International – KFMI invaded the southern part of Malawi and visited the mountainous Mulanje district with only one goal, to practice the meaning of Christianity by giving to the poor, the vulnerable, needy and preaching the Gospel.

The KFMI team led by its Chief Executive Officer Lolita Ngobeni and joined by Mulanje ECG – The Jesus Nation Church congregants paid a visit to Mulanje prison where more than four hundred inmates and prison warders gave their lives to Jesus and received blankets to alleviate some of their problems. During a service at the prison, KFMI's CEO saw a need for the prisoners to receive Holy Communion and totally surrender their lives to Christ for them to attain salvation.

From the prison, the team gathered at Mulanje ECG church where over 300 congregants and over 200 nonmembers of the church, received blankets and clothes courtesy of KFMI. The elderly, adults, youths and the under-five who were affected by the deadly Cyclone Freddy which hit the district and killed hundreds in the area earlier this year, benefitted from the initiative.

In her remarks, Ngobeni thanked the Prophet and all partners who contributed towards the initiative for exercising the word of God by giving to the vulnerable and preaching the gospel to those in prison including the poor.

**BOTSWANA GENDER BASED VIOLENCE AND PREVENTION WOMENS SHELTER**

The Kingdom Financing Millionaires of Botswana visited the Women's shelter (BGBVC) in Francistown for their second Charity Drive of the year. Th Botswana Gender based violence and prevention Women's shelter is a non-profit organization founded in 1998 by the Kagisano Society, with the aim of preventing and responding to violence to women and children, (and some men) in Botswana. The Women's shelter provides temporary shelter to women and children who have survived violence in their homes, most of who have come out of their homes with nothing to support themselves with.

KFM Botswana donated some funds towards the organization, and on the 18th of July 2022, a few kingdom financiers from Francistown together with the Botswana Coordinator gathered to go and buy some of the goods that had been requested by the shelter. The items purchased consisted of pillows and pillowcases, canned meat, canned fish, samp, vegetables, toilet paper, bath soap, toothpaste, and body lotion.

The program started off with a word of prayer and a brief introduction of who we are as KFM, and what we do. A message of the love of God was shared, and the Botswana Coordinator presented the donations to the officers.

It was unfortunate that entry was prohibited by the shelter for security reasons, so we could not meet the survivors to encourage them and to let them know that God loves them, but we sent our love through the officials. One of the officials gave a vote of thanks and closed off the event.
